## **Diversity Advisory Group Research**

A number of you have already been involved in the diversity research being undertaken on behalf of Council. The purpose of the research is to identify which groups in the community do not engage with schools' football as volunteers and what, if anything, we could do to encourage this engagement. This of course is in light of the vacancies still being carried on Council. There are opportunities to feed into a survey to give us your insight on these matters, but perhaps more importantly at this stage in the project, to attend a research day after Christmas, with dates and venues to be confirmed, but with St George's Park being the most likely venue. If you are interested in contributing to the research, which will be used to help inform our volunteer recruitment, retention and reward plans and haven't had the opportunity to do so already, please get in touch with Andrea Chilton who will refer you to the PhD student conducting this research.

#### From the Noticeboard...

#### Sanctioning and Risk Assessment

In line with FA regulations and following our usual annual review of processes, the ESFA's sanctioning forms have been updated. You will find three new forms (one for overseas trips for Associations, one for overseas trips for schools and one for unaffiliated football) on our website, here.

The associated risk assessment template has also been updated, and that too can be found on the <u>website</u>.

Please note that applications for sanctioning must be with the ESFA 28 days prior to the planned fixture/tour, to guarantee that checks can be completed in time for the approval to reach you before the event.

#### Safe Recruitment in Schools

Please see information we have received from the FA.

The FA, The Premier League and The Football League Trust supported by The Association for Physical Education have worked collaboratively to outline the minimum operating standards required by coaches working during curriculum time to support teachers in the delivery of High Quality Physical Education. The intention should not be to replace or displace teachers, but instead to support aiming for a sustainable approach.

When you are dealing with schools, or coaches that deliver in them, please can you remind them of the guidelines that exist to ensure safe recruitment.

"Working in a regulated environment with a responsibility for safeguarding children, you will be familiar with the need to conduct safeguarding checks on staff members. These criteria should be extended to sports coaches you deploy; you should ensure that coaches meet the core minimum standards for active coaches, which provide information and guidance on safeguarding children and vulnerable groups. This guidance includes the recommended level of Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check for both lead and assistant coaches."

## **ESFA Administrator Training Days**

As a part of the ESFA's Administrator Grants process, we have committed to providing all administrators, county schools' associations and partner organisations with at least one day of training and support each season, to aid the development of the administrator roles.

November 2<sup>nd</sup> saw 5 of the newest Counties to the programme attend a training event at St George's Park, with the other counties having attended initial training during the Easter school holidays in Sheffield and Oxfordshire. Each of the events followed the same format, with an emphasis on the importance of networking and all parties sharing their experiences and challenges. After a connecting activity, ESFA Chief Executive Andrea Chilton delivered a presentation on the landscape of schools' football and where the Association see the administrator roles fitting into it, along with some wider aims and targets that the ESFA are currently working towards.

Football Development Manager Andy Weston then outlined that the purpose of the training was "to support the development of the administrator programme, ensuring that the role works best for each County SFA and that we as ESFA are helping to support that in whichever way they can."

The training delivered sessions on 'Understanding Your Role' and 'Building partnerships', looking at Schools Football network Groups, working with wider organisations such as clubs, universities and leagues, ensuring that each County SFA is at the heart of schools' delivery in their area. Finally, the group discussed how ESFA can support these roles moving forward, including future training which we are planning to host during the Easter break 2018, for which information will be sent out in the coming weeks.

Overall the event was a great success, with 92% of attendees surveyed afterwards marking the events as 'Good' to 'Exceptional', with the opportunity to network being outlined as a very clear benefit by a number of parties. We look forward to our 2018 events.
